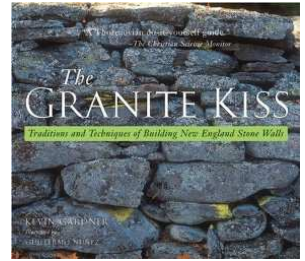

Roald Dahl Day, Wednesday, September 14th, Drop-In between 1:00-7:00 PM

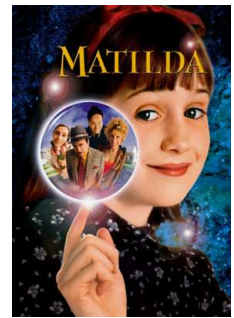


Dear Mischief Maker,

Join us to celebrate Roald Dahl's birthday with a showing of the movie adapted from his book *Matilda*.



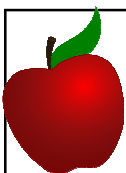
Teen Random Fandom, Thursday, September 22nd, 3:30-4:30 PM

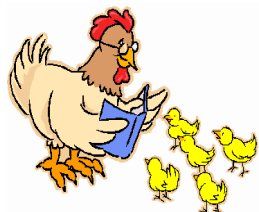
